

DAYS OUT FROM LAS RAMBLAS

TRIP 1 - ARCHENA

Use the A7 motorway (Cartegena direction) and follow the signs to Murcia, but before Murcia you will see signs to Albacete (N301).

Proceed along the N301 for about 7/8 miles till you see the sign for Archena. It is 3 kilometres to Archena and immediately you pass over the narrow iron bridge, turn right and then follow the signs for the baths (banos).

You may like to go back to Fortuna for lunch to a small bar/restaurant right in the main street where the road from Archena joins.....but you may find somewhere different.....if you do.....please let us know if it is good and we will put it into our book.

TRIP 2 - GUADALEST

Take the N332 to Alicante.

From Alicante, follow the N332 to Valencia – this becomes the A& for a while so don't panic!

You will pick up the N332 again to Valencia.

Go through Benidorm via the Ring road and pick up the sign for Collosa dien Sarria, then pick up the CV70 for Collosa. You will come to a roundabout where you will pick up a sign for Guadalest & Alcoy CV70.

Start climbing up the mountain – quite steep & circuitous. On this road you will see a RHS blue sign with a white H *** indicating a hotel/restaurant.

After approximately ¼ mile on the bend the RHS hotel, on the left side of the road above you is a restaurant (cream building with a terrace) with "Restaurant" marked in green letters on the building wall.

As the bend takes a sharp left turn with the hotel on the right hand side of the road – take an immediate left turn into the entrance for the restaurant.

BUT BE CAREFUL OF ONCOMING TRAFFIC COMING DOWN THIS ROAD!

The restaurant is called Ponsoda.

Try the Paella (freshly made) and the aoli dip & sausage

Journey time from Las Ramblas to Guadalest is about 2 hours
